To wind an automatic watch, start by removing the watch from your wrist and locating the crown on the right side of the watch face. Then, grip the crown with your thumb and forefinger and rotate it clockwise. Turn the knob 40 times, or until the second hand starts moving or you feel resistance.

How to Wind Your Rolex. Winding is standard procedure for any Rolex with a screw-down crown (which is most of them). It's done the same way for all Rolex watches, like so: 1. Unwind the crown by twisting it counterclockwise until it is free of the screw threads. 2. Twist the crown clockwise about 30 times, which will wind the movement of the watch.

Wind clockwise until you can feel resistance and stop when you have heavy tension. Over-winding could cause damage. While the number of turns varies from watch to watch, anywhere from 20 to 40 turns should do it. Gently press the stem back to its original position.

ought's A-7 Corsair II served the U.S. Navy for over over two decades, and flew with distinction during the Vietnam conflict. The subsonic A-7 was based on Chance Vought's supersonic F-8 Crusader.
