The alveoli are in the lungs, the major organ of the respiratory system. It gives oxygen to the blood and receives from it carbon dioxide through diffusion. Then the carbon dioxide goes back up the respiratory system to leave the body. The way that the lungs expand and deplete and change pressure is by the diaphragm rising and lower.
