The collection includes the Pastorals or Eclogues, a source for the Renaissance Arcadian ideal, Georgics, an agricultural poem in four parts, and Virgil's masterpiece the Aeneid, an epic poem chronicling the adventures of Aeneas, legendary ancestor of the Romans.

John Dryden (1631-1700) was the leading writer of his day and a major cultural spokesman following the restoration of Charles II in 1660. His work includes political poems, satire, religious apologies, translations, critical essays and plays.

The Major Works by John Dryden
Dryden also wrote political satires commenting on contemporary events in thinly veiled analogies. Absalom and Achitophel (1681) uses the biblical story of Absalom's rebellion against David to remark on attempts by the Earl of Shaftesbury to thwart the accession to the throne of the king's brother James, a Roman Catholic, by lobbying for Charles's illegitimate son, the Duke of Monmouth, to succeed instead.

In 1678, Dryden wrote Mac Flecknoe (1682), a work of satiric verse attacking Thomas Shadwell, one of Dryden's prominent contemporaries, for his "offenses against literature." Other works of satire, a genre for which Dryden has received significant praise, include Absalom and Achitophel (1681) and The Medal (1682).

About John Dryden | Academy of American Poets
In 1668 Dryden published Of Dramatick Poesie, an Essay, a leisurely discussion between four contemporary writers of whom Dryden (as Neander) is one. This work is a defense of English drama against the champions of both ancient Classical drama and the Neoclassical French theatre; it is also an attempt to discover general principles of dramatic criticism .
